**RE: USER PAY SCHOOL BUS ROUTES:**

- **Cross town Chilliwack Secondary - Sardis Secondary**
- **Chilliwack Mountain - Lickman overpass.**
- **Ryder Lake area to Vedder Middle and Sardis Secondary**

As you may know, the recently completed review of the school district's student Transportation Policy will result in a number of changes to transportation services.

Beginning in September 2009, the cross town Chilliwack Secondary – Sardis Secondary and Chilliwack Mountain – Lickman Overpass routes will become user pay as they are special routes established to support district programs. All current student riders must register by June 1<sup>st</sup> of each year to receive transportation services. Students new to the district or students who have a new residence after June 1<sup>st</sup> are to contact the Transportation Department to ensure they are registered bus riders. The above bus routes will continue to be provided free of charge until the end of June 2009.

The cost of this service for the 2009/2010 school year will be \$200.00 and is to be pre-paid **by August 15, 2009** at the School Board Office at 8430 Cessna Drive, Chilliwack. Fees may be paid by cash, credit card, debit card, or cheque (post dated installments, if necessary). Identification cards/bus passes will be issued to eligible riders as proof of registration and/or payment at the end of September 2009.

Please refer to the attached letter referring to the policy and registration of bus riders and complete the attached registration form. You may either give this form to the driver, fax to Transportation at 604-792-3148 or drop-off at the school.
